


THOUGHT FOR 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time (27/28th January): Jesus is different from other preachers. He doesn't proclaim a message that is a tired, old remix of what everyone had heard already. He takes the message of the prophets and the law, and he shows how, if embraced fully, it becomes a life-saving experience. And the Gospel we hear today is no mere historical account. It is a fresh, new and vibrant invitation for us to have faith in Jesus.

Second Reading: (1 Cor 7:32-35). St Paul urges everyone, but especially those who are celibate, to give their undivided attention to the Lord.

Gospel: (Mk 1:21-28). The prophecy of Moses is fulfilled in Jesus.
